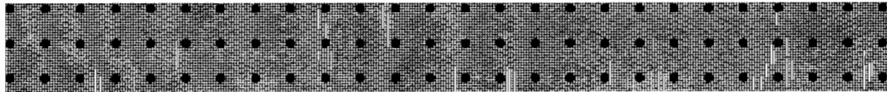

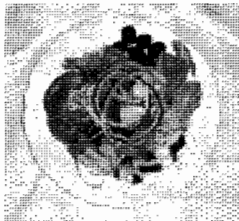

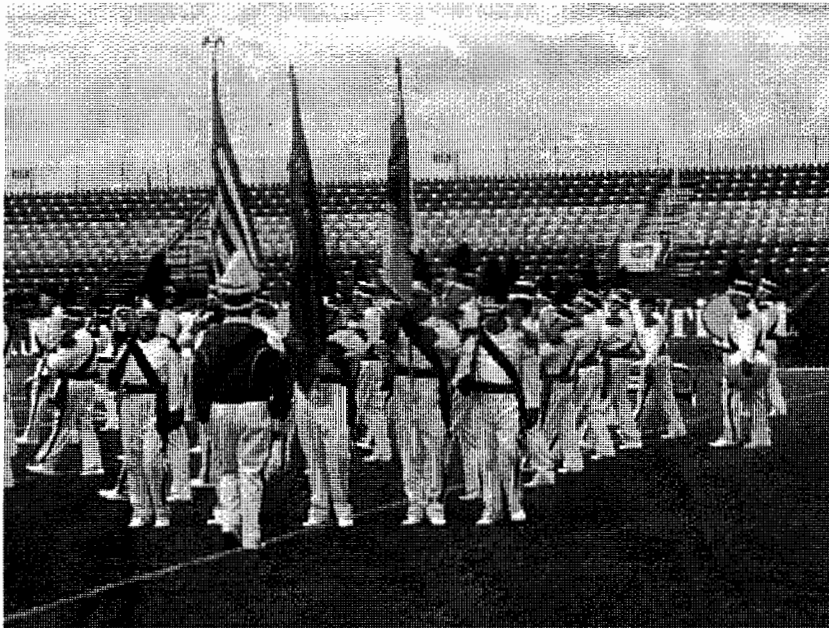
Wine Tour Is Sunday October 15th

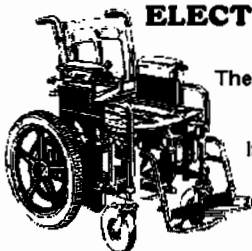
